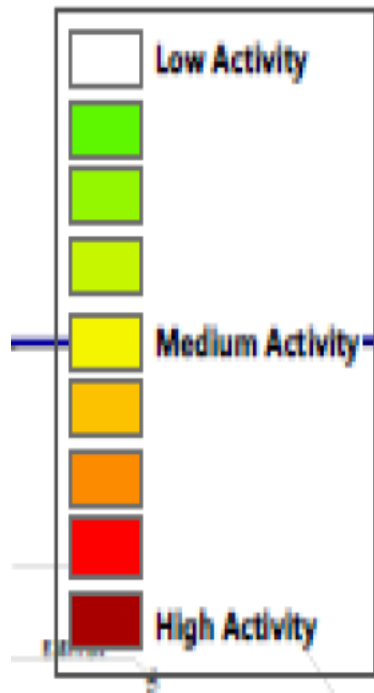
# Wardlow Questions

- What facts established reasonable suspicion in Wardlow?

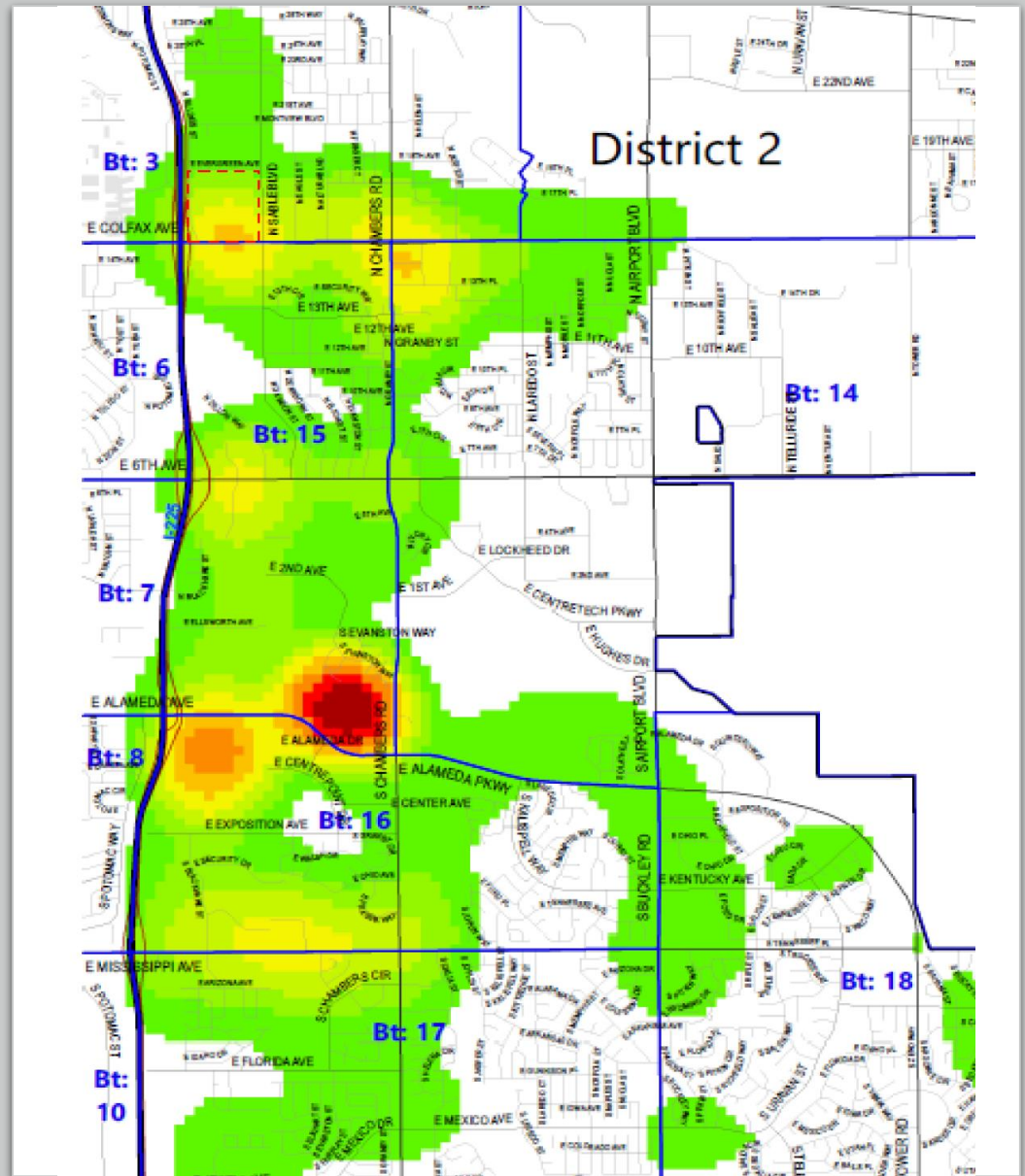
# Elijah McClain Questions

# HCA defined?

## The End of Intuition-Based Crimes (2019)

- NYPD cops call almost every block a HCA.
- Assessment almost entirely uncorrelated with actual crime data.
- Race as likely a predictor of “HCA” as crime statistics.
