
Wardlow Questions

- What facts established reasonable suspicion in <u>Wardlow</u>?


Elijah McClain Questions

The End of Intuition-Based Crimes (2019)

- → NYPD cops call almost every block a HCA.
- → Assessment almost entirely uncorrelated with actual crime data.
- → Race as likely a predictor of "HCA" as crime statistics.
